I get excited every year around this time because there is so much to celebrate! As the season of gratitude approaches, I must remind myself that thankfulness isn't just a response to good times; it's a posture of the heart. True thankfulness doesn't depend on our circumstances; it flows from recognizing the goodness and faithfulness of God in every season of life. The psalmist wrote, "Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise..." (Psalm 100:4). Gratitude is our entryway into deeper fellowship with God. When we start our prayers with thanksgiving, our worries shrink in the light of His greatness. When we thank others, we build unity and encouragement in the body of Christ. And when we practice gratitude daily, our hearts grow softer, stronger, and more joyful.

This month — and every month — let's cultivate the habit of thankfulness:

- Pause to notice God's blessings each day.
- Pray with gratitude before asking for more.
- Praise God for His goodness, even when life feels uncertain.
- Pass it on express thanks to those around you who bless your life.

A thankful heart sees God's fingerprints everywhere. As we grow in gratitude, we reflect the heart of Jesus — who, even before going to the cross, gave thanks.

May our words and actions overflow with gratitude, and may others see Christ in the way we give thanks.

I am truly thankful for each one of you and the example you are to my family on this journey together for God's glory!
